



Application form to participate in Sphere workshops in Mozambique, October/November 2021

Conditions of participation

1. Fees and expenses: There is no fee for participation in the workshops. However, the workshops are not residential, and participants should make their own arrangements for travel, accommodation, evening meals, travel/health/accident insurance and visa, as required. Snacks, water, and training materials will be provided for all workshops. Lunch will be provided for the 3-day workshops only.

2. Profile of participants: Sphere welcomes applications from anyone involved in the humanitarian response in Mozambique. Priority will be given to those who are most likely to benefit from the training and to widely disseminate their new knowledge to their partners and colleagues.

3. Managerial commitment and support: As part of the selection process, it is important that candidates are nominated or supported by their organization. Shortlisted candidates may be contacted for a brief interview, as may their supervisors to confirm their support for the candidate.

4. Presence and participation: Participants will arrive at the training site no later than 8:30 am on the first day and will leave no earlier than 5:00 pm on the last day. Participants agree to participate in all sessions, which will use a variety of learning methods.

5. Prior to the course: Participants agree to confirm their participation after the pre-selection.

6. Post-course monitoring and evaluation: Participants will develop an individual and organizational action plan during the workshop. This action plan will be submitted to their organization for validation and implementation. Participants agree to be contacted two to three months after the workshop to discuss their progress.
